**JOINT STIPULATION**

1  
2 Plaintiffs Carolina Bernal Strifling and Willow Wren Turkal (“Plaintiffs”) and Defendant  
3 X Corp., on its own behalf and as successor in interest to Defendant Twitter, Inc. (“Defendant”)  
4 (collectively, the “Parties”), by and through their undersigned counsel, hereby stipulate as  
5 follows:

6 1. On August 21, 2025, the Parties reached a settlement in principle regarding  
7 Plaintiff’s claims in this action.

8 2. On August 27, 2025, the Parties notified the Court that the Parties reached  
9 settlement in principle of this matter, noting that they expected to file a stipulated dismissal under  
10 Rule 41 within the next 30 days.

11 3. On September 2, 2025, the Court vacated all pretrial deadlines and conditionally  
12 dismissed the case with prejudice, and allowing 60 days for the Parties to file a notice if the  
13 settlement is not finalized before dismissing the case with prejudice.

14 4. As of this filing, the Parties have not finalized the settlement, but have made  
15 substantial progress and are working in good faith to diligently finalize the written settlement  
16 agreement.

17 5. The Parties now anticipate that the settlement agreement will be finalized by the  
18 end of February 2026.

19 WHEREFORE, the Parties respectfully request that the Court grant them until March 10,  
20 2026, in which to file a motion to vacate the dismissal order should settlement not occur by that  
21 time.
