

profit and loss statements of Lakeside. The motion is granted. During the conference the parties were instructed to prepare and submit to the undersigned magistrate judge a protective order which would treat all such information as confidential and which may be disclosed only for the purposes of prosecution or defense of this proceeding. The protective order will be drafted so that disclosure to experts shall obligate those persons to abide by the terms of the protective order. The court will not limit disclosure of confidential materials to persons who are not direct competitors of defendant, as requested by Lakeside, but cautions plaintiffs that the information is to be used solely for the purpose of this litigation and all persons who are allowed to review the information are to acknowledge their understanding that use for any other purpose will be deemed to be in violation of this court's order.
