<u>ORDER</u>

Before the Court are the following motions:

- 1. Bluegreen's Motion to Dismiss or in the Alternative Stay Proceedings;
- 2. Motion for Leave to Intervene by Jacque Raines and Jackie Sly;
- Bluegreen's Motion for Leave to File Supplemental Opposition to Motion to Intervene by Jackie Sly; and
- Motion of Jackie Sly to Strike Bluegreen's Supplemental Opposition to Motion for Leave to Intervene.

I. Motions Regarding Leave to Intervene

On October 31, 2002, Jacque Raines and Jackie Sly moved to intervene in this case. Defendant Bluegreen Corp. consented to Raines' intervention, but opposed intervention by Sly. Bluegreen subsequently filed a motion for leave to file supplemental opposition to Jackie Sly's intervention. Sly then moved to strike Bluegreen's supplemental opposition. One February 28, 2003, Sly withdrew her motion to intervene, mooting Bluegreen's motion for leave and Sly's motion to strike. Raines' motion is the only remaining motion for leave to intervene, and it is unopposed. The Court GRANTS Raines motion to intervene and DENIES AS MOOT Bluegreens motion for leave and Sly's motion to strike.

II. Motion to Dismiss

After reviewing Bluegreen's motion to dismiss, the Court determines that the relief requested is not warranted. Therefore, the motion is **DENIED**.
