## ORDER

Plaintiff's motion to compel discovery responses is granted. Defendant is to produce information and documents by 8/25/04:

1. Names, addresses, telephone numbers, and social security numbers of all African-American employees who worked in the warehouse at The American Bottling Company from 1/1/1999 to 12/31/2003.
2. All complaints of race discrimination, whether formal or informal, received by The American Bottling Company from 1/1/1999 to 12/31/2003.

The protective order submitted by plaintiff EEOC is adopted by the Court.

Discovery is extended to 10/13/2004.
