CONSENT ORDER

As evidenced by the signatures of counsel set forth below all parties to these actions jointly request that the Court amend the Order of December 17, 1982, entered in the <u>Campbell</u> case, to allow the administering of intake physical examinations by Physician Assistar s who have graduated from a nationally accredited program and who are also certified by the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants. This Consent Order so provides.

Upon consideration of the representations made herein, it is this A day of February, 1984:

ORDERED: That paragraph numbered (5) of the Order of December 17, 1982 be and the same is hereby vacated and in lieu thereof the following is inserted:

(4)

(5) No inmate shall be housed in double-cell or dormitory until he has received a medical examination, and it has been determined that he is not suffering from any contagious disease or other condition that would create a danger to his health or safety or to the health and safety of others if he were housed in a double-cell or dormitory.

These medical examinations are to be conducted by a Physician or by a Physician Assistant who has graduated from a nationally accredited program for the training of Physician Assistants and who has been certified by the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants, and under the supervision of a Physician pursuant to the procedures outlined in the attached proposed Health Services Order dated February 3, 1984.
