The parties to the above-entitled action have moved that this Court preliminarily approve the Settlement Agreement, approve the Settlement Notice and Summary of Settlement Notice and schedule a Fairness Hearing for final approval of the Settlement Agreement and entry of judgment dismissing this action. the Joint Motion For Preliminary Approval Of Settlement Agreement And Notice should be

GRANTED and that this order should be entered.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

a) the Settlement Notice shall be mailed to advocacy and service organizations working

with people with disabilities in the MBTA's service area identified by the plaintiffs

and the MBTA and the Summary Notice shall be published in the Boston Globe and

the Boston Herald within 10 days after the entry of this Order;

b) a Fairness Hearing for review and approval of the Settlement Agreement shall be held

at 9:30 a.m., June 15, 2006 before United States District Judge Morris E. Lasker,

Courthouse Way, Boston, MA 02210;

c) that class members or any other person with standing may appear at the Fairness

Hearing and object to judicial approval of this Settlement Agreement, provided that

Settlement Notice and the Summary Notice.
