STIPULATED JUDGMENT AND ORDER CERTIFYING PLAINTIFF CLASS AND DESIGNATING CLASS REPRESENTATIVES AND CLASS COUNSEL

Plaintiffs, Yarman Smith, et al. (collectively, "Plaintiffs") and Defendants the Board of Education of the Berkeley Unified School District (the "District"); Gerald Herrick, Director of the Office of Student Services; Michele Lawrence, Superintendent; John T. Selawsky, President of Board of Education; Nancy Riddle, Vice President of The Board of Education; Joaquin J. Rivera, Terry S. Doran, and Shirley Issel, Directors of the Board of Education (collectively, "Defendants") stipulate to the following terms of judgment and request that this Court adopt this Stipulated Judgment and the attached Consent Decree as an Order of the Court.

1. Class Certification. Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. Proc. 23(c)(3), Civil Action No. C 04-3306, styled as *Smith v. Board of Education of the Berkeley Unified School District*, shall be maintained as a class action under Fed. R. Civ. Proc. 23(b)(2) on behalf of the following class of plaintiffs:

"All African Americans and Latinos self-identified as such in official records who have been students in the Berkeley Unified School District and who have been involuntarily excluded from comprehensive school or involuntarily reassigned from comprehensive school programs to non-comprehensive alternative programs for alleged violations of the District's student conduct rules without having received appropriate due process of law," with respect to all causes of action outlined in the Complaint.

Yarman Smith, a minor, by Lagertha Smith, his guardian ad litem, Juan Muñoz, by Margarita Chavez his guardian ad litem, and Summer McNeil, by Sonobia Augustine her guardian ad litem are designated as class representatives.
