This action came before the Honorable Tena Campbell, United States District Court
Judge, for a trial by jury on February 16, 1999. Plaintiff Kristin Foote was represented by W.

Andrew McCullough, Stephen Clark, Lauren Barros, and John Pace; defendants Davis County
and Catherine Williams were represented by Robert Wallace; and defendants Roger Spiegel and
Robert Howe were represented by Rebecca Waldron and Dan Larsen. Prior court rulings held
that (1) Kristin Foote had not stated a claim under the Americans with Disabilities Act and
defendants were entitled to summary judgment on that claim; (2) Davis County, Catherine
Williams, and Roger Spiegel had violated Kristin Foote's constitutional rights by subjecting her
to a strip search at the Davis County Jail; and (3) Roger Spiegel was entitled to qualified
immunity for Kristin Foote's arrest. A jury was duly empaneled, heard the evidence and
argument of counsel, was instructed in the law, deliberated, and on February 24, 1999 answered
the special representations. By special verdict, the jury found that defendant Robert Howe

did not violate Kristin Foote's constitutional rights. The jury awarded Kristin Foote general damages in the amount of \$1.00 for the strip search at the Davis County Jail. Therefore, it is ordered and adjudged as follows:

- 1. Judgment is entered in favor of defendant Robert Howe.
- Judgment is entered in favor of plaintiff Kristin Foote and against defendants Roger
 Spiegel, Catherine Williams, and Davis County, and damages are awarded in the amount of
 \$1.00.
