Whereas the plaintiff class, immates at the Essex County Jail, filed an order to show cause as to why the County defendants should not be held in contempt of the Third Supplemental Consent Order herein, and;

Whereas this Court issued an opinion and order on November 20, 1989, granting plaintiffs' requested relief in part and modifying it in part and substantially adopting the report and recommendation of the Special Masters, and;

Whereas this Court's Order of November 20, 1989, entered on the docket on November 27, 1989, required the County defendants to deposit with the Court within 14 days from the entry of that Order the fine monies in the amount of \$1,905,300.00 for population vilations and \$1,521,300.00 for recreation violations, and;

Whereas this Court's order of December 11, 1989, entered on the docket on December 13, 1989, rescheduled the date for the payment of the above said fines to December 22, 1989, and;

Whereas this Court, after hearing argument from the parties and for good cause shown, issued an opinion on December 22, 1989, requiring the County defendants to pay the aforesaid fines no later than January 4, 1990,

1. The County defendants shall deposit the fines previously assessed in this Court's Order of November 20, 1989, no later than the close of the business day on January 4, 1990.
