STIPULATION FOR ENTRY
OF CONSENT DECREE

22 The parties above-named, by and through their respective
23 attorneys undersigned, hereby stipulate and agree that the Court
24 may enter its order and decree approving the attached proposed
25 mail regulations of the Department of Corrections of the State of
26 Arizona, and adjudging and decreeing that the same shall have the
27 same force and effect as though ordered by the Court, defendants
28 to have 45 days time from the entry of the Court's order in
29 which to fully implement said proposed regulations.

30 The attached proposed regulations are the product of
31 out-of-court negotiations between the undersigned attorneys and
32 representatives of the Department of Corrections and are accept-
able to both sides. Plaintiffs' court-appointed attorney has met

1 personally with several of the plaintiffs, including Evan Arthur
2 Hook, concerning the negotiations and the proposed regulations. A
3 copy of the proposed regulations, revised as of September 24, 1973,
4 has been furnished to plaintiffs by counsel with the recommendation
5 that they authorize counsel to enter into this stipulation. Accord-
6 ingly, counsel is filing simultaneously herewith written consent of
7 most of the named plaintiffs to the entry into this stipulation.
8 Some of the original plaintiffs have been released from the Arizona
9 State Prison since the initiation of this action, some have been
10 transferred to other institutions maintained by the Department of
11 Corrections and others are on outside trusty status and not readily
12 available for signing. Filed as attachments to plaintiffs' written
13 consent are two letters to counsel from two of the named plaintiffs,
14 including Evan Arthur Hook, evidencing their consent and explaining
15 the circumstances of circulating the consent form among the outside
16 trusties named on the form.

17 Counsel will make themselves available to the Court
18 should the Court desire to discuss the proposed regulations or any
19 other aspect of this proceeding before entry of any order or decree.
