ORDER

The State of Texas executed the plaintiff, Angel Matruino Resendiz, on June 27, 2006. Rule 25(a) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure applies in the event of a party's death. Once a suggestion of death exists, an action involving a claim that is not extinguished may proceed in favor of a proper successor. FED. R. CIV. P. 25(a). Here, however, Resendiz's death moots his request for injunctive relief, meaning that there is no continuing claim for a successor to maintain. Because Resendiz's death extinguished the claim's raised by his lawsuit, this case is dismissed.
