As a result of the status conference held in chambers on September 16, 1998, the court hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The City of Birmingham shall indicate to the parties the job classifications for which it believes no adverse impact exists.
- 2. The parties shall then determine the jobs in which the existence of adverse impact is disputed. The parties shall submit a list of disputed jobs to Dr. Veres.
- 3. Dr. Veres shall review the submitted materials and propose to the parties and to the court a model for analyzing adverse impact in the City's jobs. Dr. Veres may provide other guidance or suggestion on the issue of analyzing adverse impact in the City's jobs.
- 4. The City shall pay Dr. Veres for services performed for the City or in connection with the City's data. The City shall not be responsible for paying Dr. Veres for time spent in conferences with the court unless the time attributable to City matters is significant and easily identifiable.
- 5. The next status conference is scheduled for November 3, 1998 at 11:00 am.
