2. The parties acknowledge the privacy and business considerations involved in disclosure of Confidential materials. At the same time, the parties recognize the need to have access to evidence in the possession, custody, or control of the other party.

Therefore, in an effort to address these issues, the parties agree all Confidential materials will be so designated and will be subject to the following conditions:

- 3. If a party wishes to file any document covered by this order as an exhibit to a motion or with any other court filing, such document shall be filed under seal. Pleadings or briefs may refer to the existence of the covered documents, but if any pleading, brief or other court filing contains information obtained solely from a covered document, that submission shall be filed under seal.
- 4. The foregoing obligations of confidentiality shall not apply to any of the above persons or parties as to any part of the documents or information that was (a) previously known to or in the possession of such person or party (except to the extent it is subject to some other confidentiality obligation); (b) available to the public at the time of production; or (c) subsequently disclosed by the party seeking confidentiality to others who are not under obligations of confidentiality to the parties.
- 5. If any party to this litigation disputes the applicability of this order to any documents or information, then the parties shall attempt to resolve the dispute on an informal basis. If the
