CATE, RECESTS DIVISION - CREENAL CASE

United States v. Comey, et al. District of Colorado

This case is a prosecution under 18 U.S.C. 2h2 for illegal search and entry of a house without legal justification against five named defendants.

The evidence shows that two deputy shariffs, two private detectives and a Rudolph Regenhardt, all defendents, conducted a raid on July h, 1961, without search or arrest warrants, on the private house of Rugenia Degenhardt. The background is that Rudolph Degenhardt, who was divorced from Eugenia Degenhardt, hired a private detective to watch his ex-wife. This detective, accompanied by his assistant, two deputy shariffs and his client, broke into the house and took pictures of Eugenia Degenhardt who was made. The shariffs arrested her and a man, charging them with fermication and contributing to the delinquency of minor children. Latter charge dismissed but both convicted of fermication and fined \$25. This conviction appealed.

Indictment returned on February 27. United States Attorney is conducting further investigation before trial. No trial date has been set.
