CV-03280: plaintiffs are Andrew Thomas, et al.; defendants are Pemco Aeroplex and Precision Standard, Inc.; theory—race discrimination (hostile work environnment)

Briefly describe the procedural history of each case prior to their being related or consolidated: The EEOC's suit, 02762, was brought in September 2000, ten months after the private suit was filed. The EEOC moved to consolidate, but the motion was opposed by Pemco, and was granted only for purposes of discovery. (Later, after discovery in the other suit was over, the EEOC moved again to consolidate for trial; the motion was denied.)

After the cases were related/consolidated, what happened? The cases proceeded separately.
