08707: plaintiff is EEOC; intervenor plaintiff is Dorothy Henderson Swain; defendant is Intracostal Health System, Inc. and St. Mary's Hospital, Inc; intervenor defendant is Intracostal Health Systems, Inc., St. Mary's Hospital, Inc. Theory- job discrimination (sex).

08053: plaintiff is Dorothy Henderson Swain; defendant is Intracostal Health Systems, Inc. Theory- civil rights;jobs; notice of removal.

8. Briefly describe the procedural history of each case prior to their being related or consolidated.

08707: was filed by EEOC on 9/13/1999; judge granted motion to intervene by Dorothy Henderson Swain on 12/03/1999; judge gave scheduling orders; case referred to mediation.

08053: was filed by Dorothy Henderson Swain on 1/22/1999; court gave order to show cause and sanctioned both parties for failure to comply (subsequently vacated); case referred to mediation; discovery matters referred to magistrate judge; defendant filed motion for partial summary judgment.

9. After the cases were related/consolidated, what happened? was one case designated the lead case and all subsequent activity appears on that case docket? do both dockets contain lots of subsequent entries and if so, are they mostly or entirely duplicative, or do they indicate different types of activities in the two cases?

08707 made the lead case. Mediation held and consent decree approved on 2/6/2001. After consolidation, no further entries added to 08053.
