1 WHEREAS, the Honorable A. Wallace Tashima issued a judgment and order
2 entered on August 27, 1992, approving a Consent Decree and Agreement ("Consent
3 Decree") as a full settlement of the class claims in the above-captioned actions;
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5 WHEREAS, Paragraph 38 of the Consent Decree provides for the extension of the
6 term of the Consent Decree upon application of a party;
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8 WHEREAS, the initial 15-year term of the Consent Decree was extended for an
9 additional two years pursuant to the terms of a stipulation and order filed herein on
10 October 21, 1994, which caused the Consent Decree to be extended to 17 years from the
11 date of entry unless sooner terminated or extended and the current termination date for
12 the Consent Decree to be August 26, 2009;
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15 WHEREAS, the parties, upon application and subsequent order, stipulated to
16 extend the Consent Decree from August 26, 2009 to December 31, 2009, in order to
17 address issues raised by the represented subclasses;
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19 WHEREAS, Plaintiff Latin American Law Enforcement Association and the
20 African American Plaintiff Class have now requested the Court for an opportunity to
21 brief issues relating to Defendant City of Los Angeles' substantial compliance with
22 various terms of the Consent Decree; and
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25 WHEREAS, Plaintiff Latin American Law Enforcement Association, the African
26 American Plaintiff Class, and Defendant City of Los Angeles agree to extend the terms of
27 the Consent Decree as to the signatories of this Stipulation from December 31, 2009 to
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1 February 1, 2010, so that the parties to this stipulation may brief the issue of Defendant
2 City of Los Angeles' substantial compliance with various terms of the Consent Decree.
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4 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the termination date for the Consent Decree is
5 extended from December 31, 2009 to February 1, 2010, so that Plaintiff Latin American
6 Law Enforcement Association and the African American Plaintiff Class may brief the
7 issue of Defendant City of Los Angeles' substantial compliance with various terms of the
8 Consent Decree prior to its expiration on February 1, 2010.
