3. The South Annex Jail shall temporarily operate two floors at the housing unit capacities set forth below:

4. The South Annex Jail shall operate at the housing unit capacities set forth above within ninety (90) days of the signing of this Order, during which time defendants shall modify the existing dormitories to provide inmates with access to dayroom space, chairs and tables, and wall mounted indoor recreation equipment.

The parties intend by this paragraph to not increase the total number of beds in either the South Annex Jail or Main Jail. This paragraph does not operate to limit the replacement of existing beds as contemplated by the dormitory modifications in the South Annex Jail and the Pilot Project for the Main Jail discussed in the paragraphs below, nor does this Stipulation preclude the Sheriff from closing portions of, or all of, a jail facility due to budget shortfalls in his Department's budget.

- The parties shall meet and confer, and shall report to the Court concerning the future of the South Annex Jail after the Fresno County fiscal year 1993/94 budget is finalized.
- The Main Jail shall temporarily operate at its existing bed capacity. During the pendency of this preliminary injunction defendants shall explore the possibility of a Pilot Project in conjunction with California Board of Corrections approval. Defendants anticipate obtaining Board of Corrections approval for this Pilot Project at the July meeting of the Board. Counsel for plaintiffs will be provided with Pilot documents and may provide suggestions and comments to Board staff during the Pilot Process.
- The parties shall meet and confer after the completion of the Pilot Project application process, and shall thereafter report to the Court concerning the status of the Main Jail.
- Counsel for plaintiffs may, at reasonable times upon reasonable notice, inspect the Main Jail and South Annex Jail concerning compliance with this stipulation and concerning the issue of inmate exercise and recreation.

The parties hereby agree and stipulate to the following Permanent Injunction:

9. Defendants shall operate the North Annex Jail at the bed capacities set forth below:

- 10. Defendants are enjoined from adding beds to the North Annex Jail and from bedding inmates on the floor at the North Annex Jail.
- 11. Defendants shall operate the North Annex Jail utilizing the five additional correctional officers added to the North Annex Jail's staff as part of the settlement concerning plaintiffs' Application for Temporary Restraining Order.
- 12. Inmates in the North Annex Jail shall be provided access to one hour of daily exercise in the North Jail exercise area. Recreation time outside the housing unit will not be made up for those inmates who are away from the housing unit at other activities during the housing unit's regularly scheduled recreation. Inmates housed in discipline isolation will not be provided with recreation time during their length of stay in discipline isolation housing up to a maximum of ten [10] consecutive days.

13. The Sheriff of Fresno County is authorized by this order to release inmates from the Fresno County Jail System or refuse to accept inmates for booking into the Fresno County Jail System whenever the Fresno County Jail System, or any facility therein, or any specific housing unit therein, reaches ninety percent [90%] of capacity. The Sheriff shall release inmates or refuse to accept newly-committed inmates when the total population of the Fresno County Jail System, or any facility therein, or any housing unit therein, reaches one hundred percent (100%) of capacity.

14. In the event that an emergency threatens the Sheriff's ability to comply with these orders, counsel for defendants will notify counsel for plaintiffs no later than the next business day.

15. The above orders are effective June 17, 1993.
