The plaintiffs have filed a motion for attorney's fees and costs in the above case, and the defendants have not filed a response. Under 42 U.S.C. Section 1988 a prevailing party in a Section 1983 action such as the plaintiffs may recover "a reasonable attorney's fee."

We note first that the attorney's fee request filed in this court includes fees for some work performed in the district court. The district court docket sheet includes an order regarding attorney's fees, but we do not know what work was addressed by the order. Under the circumstances, we deny fees for the work performed in the district court without prejudice to the plaintiffs requesting those fees in that court. The fees that we deny are based on work by attorney Robert Herman consisting of 1.5 hours regarding responding to the defendants' motion for a stay, and .1 hours of a .3 hour phone call about both district court and appellate matters; and work by law clerk Timothy Kranz consisting of 8.5 hours regarding responding to the defendants' motion for a stay and .2 hours of .4 hours of phone calls about both district court and appellate matters.

We grant the remaining attorney's fee request for 77.1 hours by Mr. Herman at the requested hourly rate of \$250 (\$19,275), and 31.3 hours by Mr. Kranz at the requested hourly rate of \$125 (\$3,912.50). We therefore order

the defendants to pay the plaintiffs a total of \$23,187.50 for attorney's fees on appeal and \$33.01 for costs.
