ORDER

On August 18, 2007, the Court issued an order which directed one of the Defendants, the City of Detroit, to respond in writing why it should not be ordered to continue to pay the sum of \$141,729.17 to the monitor on a monthly basis. Ten days later, the City, as well as the Plaintiff, the United States of America (through its Department of Justice) provided written responses to the August 18th order. For the reasons that were stated on the record during a hearing on September 21, 2007, the City is directed to continue its current payment of \$141,729.17, plus expenses which shall not exceed 15%, to the independent monitor until further order from the Court. Furthermore, the City and the independent monitor are instructed to immediately enter into negotiations relating to the terms and conditions of all future monthly obligations for monitoring services in this litigation. However, if they are unable to reach an agreement by October 22, 2007, and in the absence of a modification of this directive, the Clerk of the Court is directed to schedule a hearing on these issues as expeditiously as possible.
