Respondent.

The court has reviewed the three petitions for writs of habeas corpus filed by petitioners in the above-captioned cases. All of the habeas petitions raise issues relating to revocation of petitioner's parole, the amount of time between revocation and a hearing before the Board of Prison Terms, and seek relief pursuant to a stipulated Remedial Plan entered into by the parties, including the State of California Board of Prison Terms in Valdivia v. Schwarzenegger, No. Civ. S-94-671 LKK/GGH. The court finds that the above three cases are related within the meaning of Local Rule 83-123. Accordingly, the court will order the three petitions for habeas corpus reassigned to the undersigned.

Once reassigned, the court further finds the three habeas petitions are appropriate for consolidation with <u>Valdivia</u> under Fed. R. Civ. P. 42(a). The court will order the three habeas petitions consolidated with the <u>Valdivia</u> matter and forwarded to class plaintiffs' counsel.
