ORDER VACATING SCHEDULING ORDER AND TEMPORARILY STAYING PROCEEDINGS

The Court has considered the parties' joint motion to vacate the scheduling order and temporarily stay discovery and is of the opinion that the motion should be GRANTED.

IT IS ORDERED that the current scheduling order, entered on May 22, 2012 (Docket No. 45), is VACATED and further proceedings are STAYED pending the first of either: (1) the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit ruling in the appeal of this Court's preliminary injunction; or (2) the adoption of rules for a state-funded Texas Women's Health Program by the Department of State Health Services.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 10 days of either of those events, the parties will meet and confer about what next steps they believe should be taken in this case, and will promptly advise this Court of the results of that conference.
