PARTIAL DISMISSAL ORDER



This action is partially dismissed for the reasons stated at the hearing on May 31, 1996.

The Department of Criminal Justice must submit by June 14, 1996, a two page stipulation concerning Hyde's claim about the practices at the Wynne Unit and the lawsuit mentioned in the warden's grievance response to Hyde. The Department shall provide a copy to Hyde. The case is set for review on June 19, 1996.

Hyde's claim concerning undesirable cellmates is dismissed. Hyde's claim concerning the denial of weekly religious meetings is retained.
