SHOW CAUSE ORDER

The court held a Spears hearing on May 31, 1996. The Texas Department of Criminal Justice-Institutional Division was ordered to submit by June 14, 1996, a two page stipulation concerning Hyde's claim about the practices at the Wynne Unit and the lawsuit mentioned in the warden's grievance response. Two months have passed and the TDCJ-ID has made no attempt to respond. This failure convinces the court that they lack due diligence.


