A conference was held at the Magistrate Judge's Office on May 23, 1991. The U.S. Government was represented by Attorney Gayle Fidler of the U.S. Department of Justice. The Territory of the V.I. was represented by Attorneys Ford Adiyia and Elliott Davis of the V.I. Department of Justice. Also participating were General Moorhead, Co-ordinator of Prison Repairs for the V.I. Department of Justice and Isadore Bell and Samuel Garnett of the Bureau of Corrections, V.I. Department of Justice.

A point by point review of compliance with particular aspects of the Consent Decree was conducted. In furtherance of such discussion it is ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Quarterly reports shall be co-ordinated and submitted by the V.I. Department of Justice, commencing with the quarter terminating June 30, 1991. The reports shall track compliance with all aspects of the Consent Decree and shall be on standardized forms. The reports shall be mailed to plaintiff by express mail or equivalent service no later than the 15th day of the month following the completed quarter.
