IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that judgment is entered in favor of the defendants and against the plaintiffs on the plaintiffs' claims under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act ("IDEA"), 20 U.S.C. § 1400, et seq, 42 U.S.C. § 1983, and § 504 of the Rehabilitation Act.

The plaintiffs did not exhaust their administrative remedies under IDEA. Therefore, the defendant's motion for judgment on the pleadings is GRANTED.

Judgment is entered in favor of defendant Milwaukee Public Schools and against Disability Rights of Wisconsin in the amount of \$459,123.96.

This action is hereby DISMISSED.
