

Staff responded that an investigation of inmate Corbett's concern revealed that on the date in question, the amount of force used in this incident was a result of inmate Corbett's demonstrated negative behavior which resulted in the incident's occurrence and subsequent amount of force being used. Staff indicated that there was no evidence found to suggest that inmate Corbett had been treated in any manner not in accordance with applicable policies and or standard operating procedures.

This Examiner spoke with the investigating officer, Lt. Clayburn and was advised that policies and procedures were followed in this incident and that the use of force involving inmate Corbett was warranted and justifiable. This Examiner reviewed the Use of Force Report and Witness Statements and could not find any evidence of wrongful treatment. Inmate Corbett is advised in the future to be mindful of his actions and follow instructions given by staff.

This examiner has carefully reviewed the grievance and the response given by staff in the DC-410A response. From this review, I am convinced that staff has adequately addressed this inmate's grievance concerns. I adopt the facts found by the staff investigator.

On this record, this inmate's allegations are insufficiently supported. Thus, this grievance is dismissed for lack of supporting evidence.
