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Jackson Plan of Action Agreement to Modify Sexuality Outcomes

Pursuant to ¶ 13 of the Stipulation on Disengagement, the Plaintiffs and Defendants agree that Outcomes C, D, E, F, G, I, and J and the corresponding Activities in the Plan of Action Appendix 9 (sexuality) that have not already been disengaged by the Court are replaced by the following Outcomes and Activities.

Outcome C: The Division will provide a statewide program of socialization, education, training and supports related to sexuality for all persons with developmental disabilities

Activity 1: The Division will adopt the Sexuality Services Plan, dated February 1, 2006, that describes in detail training programs for families and providers, sexuality education and socialization skills for all persons with developmental disabilities, sexuality supports for clients of the Division, and therapy services for victims of abuse.

Activity 2: The plan will be coordinated and monitored by the Office of Behavioral Services and its Clinical Consultant. Monitoring, as required by this Activity, is defined as the following: assessing the adequacy of implementation, taking action as needed, and identification and reporting of any modifications needed to the Sexuality Services Plan.

Activity 3: The plan will be implemented by December 1, 2006.

Activity 4: By October 1, 2006, the Division will issue policies and procedures that incorporate all of the central provisions of the plan.

Outcome D: The Division will provide an effective support system for individuals exhibiting sexually inappropriate or sexually offending behaviors.

Activity 1: The Division will adopt the Sexuality Services Plan, dated February 1, 2006, that describes in detail the process for assessing risk, evaluating needs, and planning, delivering, and monitoring supports to persons with sexually inappropriate or sexually offending behavior.

Activity 2: The plan will be coordinated, managed and monitored by the Office of Behavioral Services and its Clinical Consultant. Monitoring, as required by this Activity, is defined as the following: assessing the adequacy of implementation, taking action as needed, identification and reporting of any modifications needed to the Sexuality Services Plan.

Activity 3: The plan will be implemented by December 1, 2006.

Activity 4: By October 1, 2006, the Division will issue policies and procedures that incorporate all of the central provisions of the plan.
