Pursuant to the Mandate Order of the Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals in the captioned matter, the Court enters Judgment as follows:

(1) Ohio Rev. Code § 3599.45 is declared unconstitutional in its entirety as violating the First and Fourteenth Amendments to the Constitution of the United States;

(2) A permanent injunction is entered against Defendant Secretary of State of Ohio Jon Husted in his official capacity, enjoining him from enforcing Ohio Rev. Code § 3599.45 against those candidates to whom named Plaintiffs in this case may elect to make campaign contributions, or from enforcing the statute against Plaintiffs themselves.

Plaintiffs may petition the Court for attorneys' fees and costs as prevailing parties under 42 U.S.C. § 1988, and move to tax costs under Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(b).
