STIPULATION

In connection with the Consent Decree agreed to by the parties Naventes on Decree, 1993 in the above captioned case, it is stipulated by counsel for the various State defendants as follows:

- 1. The Sanitary Code of the State of Louisiana (1984), promulgated by the State Health Office pursuant to La.R.S. 40:4, and, in particular, Chapter XVIII relating to jails and prisons, is the applicable regulation for determining compliance with the State Health Code. The exception to this rule is that Sections 18:007 and 18:008 do not apply to the Old Parish Prison Building.
- 2. Chapter 17 of the Louisiana Administrative Code and La.R.S. 40:1561-1596.5 as they reference the general powers and procedures of the Fire Marshal's Office [both printed in the Official Manual of the Louisiana Fire Marshal (1992), promulgated by the State Fire Marshal pursuant to La.R.S.40:1563(F)], are the applicable regulations for determining compliance with the State Fire Code.
