- On or before June 18, 2010, Defendants will submit a written report regarding the status of the application for a waiver by the federal government to permit Defendants to move forward with their proposed crisis stabilization program. Included in this report will be a review of Defendants' analysis of other state plans approved by the federal government crisis for stabilization programs. Crisis stabilization programs are a critical part of the system embodied in the court's Remedial Order, and, as the state concedes, all best efforts must be made promptly to establish this program component.
- 2. Plaintiffs having submitted their proposed order regarding waiting lists to access the intensive care coordination program, Defendants will respond by June 18, 2010.
