- 6. The state law claims asserted against Officer Baxter and Lieutenant Sheelor in their official capacities in Counts VI and VII are DISMISSED;

7. The Privacy Protection Act claim asserted in Count V is DISMISSED with respect to all

9. All other claims will proceed.
