STIPULATION DISMISSING DEFENDANT HENNESSEY

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Plaintiffs Elizabeth Aida Haskell, Reginald Ento, Jeffrey Patrick Lyons, Jr., and Aakash Desai, on behalf of themselves and others similarly situated ("Plaintiffs"); Defendants Edmund G. Brown Jr., Attorney General of California, and Eva Steinberger, Assistant Bureau Chief for DNA Programs, California Department of Justice ("State Defendants"); and Defendant Michael Hennessey, Sheriff for the County of San Francisco ("City Defendant") (collectively "All Defendants"), by and through their counsel, hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

RECITALS

- 1. Plaintiffs filed a Class Action Complaint for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief on October 7, 2009 (the "Complaint"). The Complaint challenges a provision of California law that requires collection of DNA samples from individuals arrested or charged with any felony at the time of their arrest. The Complaint alleges that this practice violates the Fourth Amendment as well as substantive and procedural due process as protected by the Fourteenth Amendment.
 - 2. Plaintiffs filed a First Amended Complaint on December 1, 2009.
- 3. All parties now agree that venue in this District is proper and that no local law enforcement agency is a necessary party to this action because all such agencies will be bound by any injunction against the State Defendants under Fed. R. Civ. P. 65. Accordingly, the parties have agreed that Defendant Hennessey should therefore be voluntarily dismissed without prejudice pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii).

NOW THEREFORE, Plaintiffs and All Defendants hereby stipulate to the following:

AGREEMENT

Plaintiffs hereby voluntarily dismiss Defendant Hennessey without prejudice pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). The Parties further agree that in the event Plaintiffs move in the future to name Mr. Hennessey as a Defendant in this action (or name him in another action challenging the collection of DNA), the provisions of Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(d) will not apply.
