ORDER

Plaintiff, United States of America, and Defendant, Texas Champion Bank, requested that the Court vacate the final judgment entered on March 5, 2013 [Dkt. Entr. 11]. Paragraph 38 of the Consent Order [Dkt. Entr. 3-1] provides that the Court shall retain jurisdiction for the duration of the Consent Order to enforce the terms of the Order, after which time the case shall be dismissed with prejudice. While the parties have represented that they have no objection to the matter being administratively closed, there are certain aspects of the Consent Order that have not yet been fulfilled and may require Court approval or intervention. The Consent Order expires on June 5, 2017, three months after the submission of the bank's fourth annual report.

For the reasons stated above, it is hereby ORDERED that the final judgment entered on March 5, 2013 is VACATED. This case shall be administratively closed but this Court shall retain jurisdiction over this matter to address any issues with the Consent Order that may arise.
