Pursuant to Local Rule 7.3, the Parties hereby enter into the following stipulation:

WHEREAS the Plaintiff initially alleged claims in this action against the following

federal government entities and government officials in their official capacities only: the Department of Homeland Security, the Department of Justice, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Terrorist Screening Center, Donna Bucella, Michael Chertoff, Alberto Gonzales, and Robert Mueller;

WHEREAS the claims alleged against the governmental entities and government officials in their official capacities were for the expungement of any records of Plaintiff's material witness arrest and time in detention following that arrest;

WHEREAS the governmental entity defendants provided Plaintiff with evidence showing that no such records are maintained;

WHEREAS, based on the evidence provided by the governmental entities, the Plaintiff withdrew the claims against those entities and the federal government officials sued in their official capacities;

WHEREAS the only defendants remaining in this action are Michael James Gneckow and Scott Mace, who are sued in their individual capacities, and the United States, on claims brought under the Federal Tort Claims Act;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby stipulated by and between the Plaintiff and the Defendants that:

- 1. Because Plaintiff has withdrawn his claims against the governmental entities that were initially parties to this action—the Department of Homeland Security, the Department of Justice, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Terrorist Screening Center—those entities are no longer parties to this action and the Clerk should terminate them as parties;
- 2. Because Plaintiff has withdrawn his claims against the government officials sued in their official capacities that were initially parties to this action—Donna Bucella, Michael

Chertoff, Alberto Gonzales, and Robert Mueller—those officials are no longer parties to this action and the Clerk should terminate them as parties;

- 3. The caption of this case should reflect only those parties who remain defendants in this case—the United States, Michael James Gneckow, and Scott Mace;
  - 4. The proper caption for this case is *Abdullah al-Kidd v. United States, et al.*
