It is recommended that the above case be closed for the following reasons:

This case, dealing with conditions at the St. Louis City Jail, was litigated in 1974 and 1975, with initial success. The District Court failed to followup on its initial ruling, however, and denied our motion for further relief in late 1975. We filed a notice of appeal and then moved to dismiss the appeal.

All issues have thus been finally litigated. Defendants are in basic compliance with the very vague and only partially effective decree that remains in effect.

In essence, while this case is in a less than satisfactory posture, there is just nothing left to do. I therefore recommend that the file be closed.
