STIPULATED ORDER

Whereas Occupy Delaware filed this ac tion on November 9, 2011 seeking, *inter alia*, an order e njoining the City of Wilmington ("City") from preventing Occupy Delaware from conducting an "occupation" on Peter Spencer Plaza ("Plaza");

Whereas the City filed on May 9, 2012 a counterclai m seeking the ejectment of Occupy Delaware from the Plaza;

Whereas the Plaza is to be renovated, and renovations are expected to begin with the closure of the Plaza (ex cept for limited foot traffic) and tree demolition starting on September 17, 2012, and

Whereas the renovations will require that the Plaza be vacated, and;

Whereas by agreeing to this Stipulated Order neither party a grees to or admits to any of the allega tions of the other party in the suit now pending before Chancery Court, which is scheduled for tr ial on August 20, 2012, and the parties request that the trial be taken off the Cour t's calendar if this Stipulated Order is approved by the Court.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED this _____ day of _____, 2012 that:

 Occupy Delaware will remove all tents, signs and other structures or items it (or its members) ha ve placed on the Plaza, an d vacate the Plaza on or before September 10, 2012 or, if renovations begin later than September 17, 2012, 7 days prior to the start of renovations;

2. Occupy Delaware shall not add any tents, signs or other structures to the encampment as it existed on the date th is Stipulated Order was executed by all counsel, and the City shall not seek to have any tents, signs or other structures removed prior to the t ermination of the encampment, absent a hea lth and safety issue;

3. The November 10, 2011 agreement is terminated;

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4. This order shall be binding on all parties to this action and all persons acting in concert with them.

5. Each party shall bear its own attorneys fees and costs.
