Below are specific changes to the Revised Order approving the plan between the School Board of Indian River County and the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, Indian River County Branch, which was originally ordered into effect by the Honorable Judge C. Clyde Atkins on the 23rd of May, 1994.

## Section 1. Facilities Reorganization

- Vero Beach Junior High School will become the ninth grade center for Vero Beach High School in order to prevent over-crowding on the high school campus.
- There will only be three middle schools in Indian River County in order to serve all students in grades six through eight: Sebastian, Gifford, and the new south county middle schools.
