LeBlanc, Nathan Burl Cain, Angelia Norwood, and the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections and AGAINST Plaintiffs Elzie Ball, Nathaniel Code, and James Magee as to Plaintiffs' claims under Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act, as modified by the Americans with Disabilities Act Amendment Act and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiffs shall file their motion for attorneys' fees no later than July 14, 2014.
