ORDER

In accordance with the Opinion of this Court;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant Patricia L. Caruso's Motion for More Definite Statement and for Partial Summary Judgment (Dkt. No. 24) is **GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART** in that Defendant's request for a more definite statement is **GRANTED**, but Defendant's requests for partial summary judgment are **DENIED** without prejudice to later motion.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff Michigan Protection & Advocacy Service, Inc.'s Motion for Protective Order (Dkt. No. 29) is **GRANTED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff shall provide a more definite statement within 14 days of this Order by the filing a Second Amended Complaint in compliance with W.D. Mich. L.Civ.R. 10.7, which Complaint shall name prisoners by anonymous number, but shall reference a sealed appendix which appendix shall indicate the names and prisoner numbers assigned to each of the persons named by anonymous number. The appendix shall be filed under seal and disclosed to defense counsel, but shall not otherwise be disclosed to the public except for necessary disclosures

to prosecute and defend this suit. The Second Amended Complaint may also include other amendments, though such amendments are not required by this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any discovery materials produced or disclosed in this suit and any trial exhibits shall preserve the confidentiality of the prisoners' identities and health information.
