ORDER AMENDING ORDER OF MARCH 22, 1966

The order of this Court made and entered herein on March 22, 1966, recited that race or color will henceforth not be a factor in hiring or assigning teachers and other professional staff. The effect of this order was to require the Montgomery County Board of Education to commence the process of desegregating the faculty and professional staff commencing with the school year 1966-67.

This Court judicially notes the action taken by the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit on August 16, 1966, in the Mobile school case of Birdie Mae Davis, et al. v. Board of School Commissioners of Mobile County, Alabama, et al., ___ F. 2d ___, wherein, as to the desegregation of the faculty and staff in the Mobile school system, the Mobile County Board of Education has been allowed until the school year 1967-68 to end its policy of hiring and assigning teachers and staff according to race. Uniformity, as well as fairness, requires this Court upon its own motion, therefore, to amend its order of March 22, 1966, to the extent that the Montgomery County School Board of Education be allowed until the school year 1967-68 to end its present policy of hiring and assigning teachers and other school personnel according to race.

It is, therefore, the ORDER, JUDGMENT and DECREE of this Court that the order of this Court made and entered herein on March 22, 1966, be and the same is hereby amended to the extent that the Montgomery County Board of Education

be, and said Board is, hereby allowed until the school year 1967-68 to commence desegregation of the faculty and professional staff in the Montgomery County school system.

It is further ORDERED that the Montgomery County Board of Education report to this Court by June 15, 1967, the planned assignment of the faculty and professional staff to each school for the 1967-68 school year by race and grade.
