PETITION

COMES NOW the petitioner, Jesse W. Williams, and sets forth the following facts in support of this his appeal from the decision of the defendant, Compensation Board:

1. That he is the sheriff of Patrick County, Virginia, having been duly elected to this position effective January 1, 1980.

2. That in accordance with §14.1-50 of the Code of Virginia, the petitioner filed his requests for salaries of deputy sheriffs and other members of his department, said requests being filed prior to March 1, 1981.

3. That on June 10, 1981, the said Compensation Board conducted a hearing at which time the requests of the petitioner with reference to the salaries of his deputies were considered.

4. That on June 15, 1981, the Compensation Board set the salaries of the deputies and other members of the Sheriff's Department.

5. On the said date, the Compensation Board set the salary of Deputy Sheriff Clifford Boyd at \$15,293.00. The petitioner had requested a salary of \$17,410.00 for the said Deputy Sheriff Clifford Boyd.


6. The petitioner contends that the said salary of \$15,293.00 set for Clifford Boyd is inadequate given his education, experience, and the wide range of duties assigned to him by the

Petitioner.

WHEREFORE, the Petitioner respectfully notes his appeal from the decision of the Compensation Board, and respectfully requests the Judges of this Court to fix the salary of Deputy Clifford Boyd at an adequate level as provided by law, and for such other and further relief as may be necessary.
