NOTICE TO BE GIVEN CLASS

16 The representative plaintiffs and the defendants having
17 entered into a settlement of this action subject to the approval
18 of the Court, as set forth in the Settlement dated 2 April 1979
19 heretofore filed in this case, and the court having duly con-
20 sidered the proposed settlement and judgment and the arguments
21 and documentation presented in support thereof by both sides
22 and, it appearing to the court that the proposed settlement
23 merits consideration as to its fairness and reasonableness and
24 that a hearing should be held thereon to determine whether the
25 settlement and judgment should be approved by the Court and that
26 notice of the hearing should be given to the members of the
27 plaintiff class as required by Rule 23(e) of the Federal Rules
28 of Civil Procedure,

29 IT IS ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

30 1. A hearing shall be held before the undersigned
31 United States District Judge, United States Court House, 230
32 North First Avenue, Phoenix, Arizona 85025 at 10 o'clock A m.,
on the 4 day of June, 1979.

1 for the purpose of determining whether the proposed settlement
2 of this action is fair and reasonable and judgment should be
3 entered in accordance with the terms and provisions of the
4 settlement.

5 2. Notice of the hearing shall be sent by first class mail

7 to all known persons legally responsible for members of the
8 plaintiff class at addresses provided by the Department of
9 Economic Security. Content of the notice shall be as attached.

10 3. Further, plaintiffs will issue a press release
11 relating in substance the information which is contained in the
12 notice to members of the plaintiff class.

13 4. Proof of giving such notice as hereinabove directed
14 shall be filed in this court prior to the date of the hearing.

15 5. Any person who wishes to be heard in objection to
16 or support of the Proposed Settlement and Judgment must file a
17 written statement of objection or support with the Clerk of the
18 Court, United States District Court, District of Arizona, 230
19 North First Avenue, no later than ¹⁰20 days before the hearing. A
20 copy of the statement should be mailed to Robert Beckett, Attor-
21 ney for the plaintiffs, ~~401 North First Avenue~~, Phoenix, Arizona
22 85003 and to ^{Robert Segebauer}~~Charleen Greer~~, Assistant Attorney General, Attor-
23 ney for defendants, ~~1700 West Washington~~, Phoenix, Arizona 85005.
24 Any papers filed with this Court must comply with local rules and
25 the Rules of Federal Procedure. No person shall be heard, and
26 no briefs or papers received or considered, unless served and
27 filed as indicated except as the court, in its discretion, may
28 otherwise direct.
