## MINUTE ORDER

Glanz, 948 F. 2d 1562, 1565 (10th Cir. 1991)); see also Robinson v. Dean Foods Co., No. 08-cv-01186-REB-CBS, 2009 WL 723329, at \*4 (D. Colo. Mar. 18, 2009) (citation omitted) ("Generally, when an amended complaint is filed, the previous complaint is wiped out and the operative complaint is the most recently filed version.").
