Dear Mr. Glenn:

I am enclosing 15 copies of a complaint in which the United States, as plaintiff, seeks an injunction against the Sumter County School District No. 2, Sumter, South Carolina, the members of its Board of Trustees and its superintendent, to prevent racial segregation in the public schools of the District of children of military personnel and civilian employees of the Armed Services.

I have enclosed a sufficient number of complaints for service on each defendant, for filing and for your office. Please note that one of the complaints, labeled original, is signed by all counsel for the plaintiff but yourself and requires your signature.
