- (6) Prepare legal memoranda such as that pertaining to the 2283 issue.
- (7) Obtain all studies regarding the structure of the legal profession and methods of engaging counsel; see report by Twentieth Century Fund cited in the Fleischer-Pochods memorandum and Vern Countryman's book on the legal profession.
