No. 95), the United States filed a consolidated response to the Motion to Intervene and the Motions for Extension. Dkt. No. 96. Pursuant to Local Civil Rules 7(d)(2) and 7(d)(3), the reply briefs of the City and the CPC are currently due November 8, 2013.

The parties and CPC are currently exploring possible alternatives to intervention by the CPC, and would benefit from additional time to continue to discuss these issues. To allow for this additional time, the parties wish to extend the noting date for the Motion to Intervene and the Motions for Extension from November 8 to November 13, 2013.

The parties therefore respectfully move this Court to extend the noting date for the Motion to Intervene and the Motions for Extension until November 13, 2013. Under this schedule, pursuant to Local Civil Rules 7(d)(2) and 7(d)(3), the reply briefs of the City and the CPC in support of these motions would be due on November 13, 2013.
