**MEMORANDUM SUBMITTING
REVISION TO MONITORING
PLAN DEADLINE**

Pursuant to ¶ 183 of the Settlement Agreement and Order of Resolution (“Consent Decree”), it is the responsibility of the Monitor to submit to the Court, with the Parties’ approval, a Monitoring Plan “setting out deadlines for policy, training . . . and . . . for conducting the compliance reviews and audits [in] this matter” (the “Monitoring Plan”). Dkt. No. 3-1 ¶ 183.

The Plan called for a report on SPD’s community policing and outreach practices by December 3, 2015 (the “public confidence assessment”). Dkt. No. 221-4 at 6. Subsequently, the Monitor indicated to the Court that a time extension was necessary to “enable the Parties and the Monitor to complete the assessments with adequate input from some key stakeholders in this process and still in a timely manner.” Dkt. 252 at 1-2. The Court approved revising the

1 deadline for the public confidence assessment to January 22, 2016. Dkt. No. 257.

2 The Parties and Monitor have engaged in important and collaborative discussions about
3 the assessment and the report on its findings over the past several weeks, and the Monitor
4 has required additional time to finalize incorporation of important information received during
5 these discussions. In the wake of maintenance to the Court's electronic filing system late on
6 January 22, 2016, the Monitor informed the Court through its clerk of the need for a small
7 amount of additional time to finalize the assessment. The Parties and Monitor here formally
8 reiterate their request that the deadline for the public confidence assessment be extended to
9 January 27, 2016, with a final report filed with the Court on that date.
