STATE OF LOUISIANA VS. GARY DUNCAN

Simple Battery

This matter was called.

Mrs. Del Norte M. Lancaster was duly sworn as the  
Official Court Reporter.

Defense Counsel announced to the Court that the  
accused was ready for sentencing, however, before sentencing, he  
would request a suspended sentence and presented statement in  
support thereof.

The Court answered counsel and then sentenced the  
said Gary Duncan to pay a fine of \$150.00 and costs and serve  
Sixty days in Parish Prison; additional twenty days in the event  
fine and costs are not paid.

Defense Counsel presented to the Court his Bill of  
Exception No. 1 to the Court's previous ruling on the demand for  
trial by jury. Defense Counsel further presented to the Court  
his Notice of Intention to Apply for a Writ of Certiorari and the  
Court signed the Order fixing the return day in the Supreme Court  
of Louisiana for February 13, 1967. The Court then ordered the  
appearance bond cancelled and the new bond fixed in the sum of  
\$1500.00 pending the decision of the Supreme Court of Louisiana  
on the application.

Prisoner remanded.
