(Mot. (Dkt. #75); see also TRO Mot. (Dkt. #9).) 17 18 Specifically, WSLC's amicus brief will address "the impacts of the most recent 19 Executive Order on the members of unions across a wide range of industries and the 20 irreparable harm suffered by those workers in Washington if the Executive Order is not enjoined." (Mot. at 3.) The court has stayed its consideration of Plaintiffs' motion for a 21 temporary restraining order. (Order (Dkt. #79).) Accordingly, although the court 22
